



# Bone & Soft Tissue Cancer

Patients diagnosed with bone or soft tissue cancer may undergo demanding and extensive treatments which can have a major impact on their quality of life. Nurses and other health care professionals play an important part in the delivery of care to meet the needs of this group of patients in a variety of settings from acute hospital practice to rehabilitation and palliative care. This module has been written in collaboration with the Scottish Sarcoma Network and will enhance understanding of the management, care and rehabilitation of the adolescent, adult and family diagnosed with bone and soft tissue cancer.
